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


• SITE LOCUS AND GIS FIGURES






LOCUS PLAN MUSKRAT MARSH RESTORATION APRIL 2008 FRIENDS OF ALEWIFE RESERVATION







ATTACHMENT B PROJECT DESCRIPTION



Project Description

Friends of Alewife Reservation, with the permission of the landowner, BHX, LLC, as Trustee of Acorn Park Holdings Realty Trust, is proposing to undertake a small restoration pilot project in the freshwater marsh known locally as Muskrat Marsh. Specifically, it is proposed to restore approximately 1,000 square feet of area within the marsh that is dominated by *Phragmites* sp.

At present, there is a small area in the marsh adjacent to Acorn Park that supports a diverse wet meadow with such wetland wildflowers as Blue Vervain (*Verbena* sp) and shrub species. The intent of the restoration project is to try to expand the diverse area.

This project is undertaken as a restoration project per 10.53 (4), which allows for projects which will improve the natural capacity of a resource area to protect the interests of the Wetlands Protection Act.

The project would be conducted in phases as follows:

Summer 2008

A small test plot, approximately 1,000 square feet in area, is proposed to be managed for invasives species removal and native planting. Specifically, *Phragmites* will be cut and their roots removed to the maximum extent. Clean loam may be placed in the area of the removed roots and native plants would be planted. Plants proposed at present include, for example, Weeping Willow (*Salix babylonica*) because its roots may be aggressive enough to combat the Phragmites' root system. Other plants would be selected specifically to provide improved habitat to the known wildlife species in the area.

In addition, there are a few single plants of multi flora rose (*Rosa multiflora*). It is proposed to dig them out by the roots.

Purple loosestrife (*Lythrum salicaria*) would be removed by hand.

All work would be conducted by volunteers.

Fall 2008

If approved by the Conservation Commission, FAR may also obtain the services of a licensed herbicide applicator to remove the Phragmites. Application of herbicides to Phragmites should be conducted in the fall, as the plant begins to senesce and draws nutrients into its roots. Broadcast application would not be conducted.

Spring and Summer 2009

During the late spring of 2009, a monitoring program would begin to evaluate the success of the planted materials and the success of invasives removal.

In summary, the proposed activities would be conducted to expand the diverse wet meadow/shrub community adjacent to Acorn Park Road and act as a pilot to see if a larger restoration effort is feasible in the area.


