In the talk, Quincy Historical Society Executive Director Ed Fitzgerald will explore what we know about the Captain and his adventures in Quincy. Wollaston Monument, Maypole Park, the site of Thomas Morton's May Day festival and the remains of colonist Edmund Quincy's tide mill.
